

POPPY RIDGE GOLF COURSE - GOLF OPERATING PROCEDURES

July 28, 2020

1. The Clubhouse remains closed. Access to the golf shop is limited to a total of four individuals maintaining social distancing. Only one individual per reservation will be permitted in the golf shop to pay the fees for the entire group. Payment must be made by credit or debit card; no cash will be accepted. Face coverings are required for entry into the golf shop per county guidelines
2. Golfers must bring their own clubs, as no rental sets are available. In addition, golfers are responsible for transporting their own clubs at all times
3. The driving range is open subject to social distancing requirements. A maximum of 14 individuals will be permitted to use the range at one time. The stalls are spaced out to maintain social distancing. Chipping areas and practice putting greens are open, subject to social distancing guidelines
4. Golfers may: (a) walk and carry their own clubs, (b) take a golf cart, if reserved at the time of booking, with a limit of one person per cart (unless golfers are living in the same household), or (c) bring their own pushcart, which is encouraged. Poppy Ridge will have a limited number of pushcarts available for a \$10 fee, upon request
5. Golfers may play in groups up to four players and are required to maintain proper social distancing throughout the round. Marshals will be on the course throughout the day enforcing social distancing
6. Golfers may play "preferred lies" in the bunkers. Flagsticks remain in the holes and are not to be touched at any time. The holes have been filled with a pool noodle that prevents the ball from dropping to the bottom of the hole
7. Food and Beverage offerings will be available on a limited basis on the patio, subject to space availability. Customers are required to follow procedures as directed by staff, in compliance with CDPH and Alameda County protocols. Additionally, a beverage cart will be available on the course (along with the snack bar adjacent to the Clubhouse) and will be operated for takeout service only
8. Outdoor and on-course restroom facilities will be open with a limit of one person at a time and sanitized regularly, and golfers are encouraged to minimize use of common touch points while utilizing
9. Gatherings of any groups are not allowed prior to the beginning of the round, during the round, or at the end of the round under any circumstances
10. Food and beverage will be available for takeout between the hours of 11am and 4pm Monday through Friday, and between 8am and 4pm on Saturdays and Sundays.
